- Tuesday, October 5: Enabling Greater Connectivity
  - o Why do we need connectivity? How does connectivity affect our lives? Which innovations drive our every day life?
- Wednesday, October 6: Sustainable Connectivity
  - o How can communication technologies work on their ecological footprint? And how, in return, can communication technologies help developing a sustainable society? Which opportunities arise through modern communication technologies like 5G in regards to a more inclusive digital society?
- Thursday, October 7: Enabling the Connectivity of Tomorrow
  - o Which innovations are envisioned in terms of future communication network and a more efficient use of spectrum? Which opportunities lie ahead through combining different technologies?

The conference aims at combining various perspectives, be it from scientists and researchers from all scientific backgrounds or from project leaders working on applied use cases.

- All talks are **in English**.
- Talks can be either **quick talks** and **keynote speeches**.
- Since the conference will be organized in a hybrid way, talks and presentations have to fit the local and the online audience.
- Talks can be done either **physically** or **remotely**. A physical presence for speakers is preferred. The conference team will inform you and will keep you updated on the evolution of the Covid restrictions in Luxembourg.
